

DATES OF WORK IN CANADA INSTRUCTIONS

1) List all dates of work in Canada from 1 April 2011 to date.

In the example, 1 July 2011 to 11 November 2011 and 1 March 2012 to 17 August 2012, gives a total amount of days worked in Canada of 10 months and 7 days.

2) Please add duration of current LMIA to total previous time worked in Canada as determined in Question 1).

*Please use 31 days per month as a standard number of days to determine months of work.

A worker cannot work more than 48 months in Canada. A Visa Officer will add previous time worked in Canada to the duration of the current LMIA and will only issue the work permit if the total is less than 48 months or until 48 months is reached.
