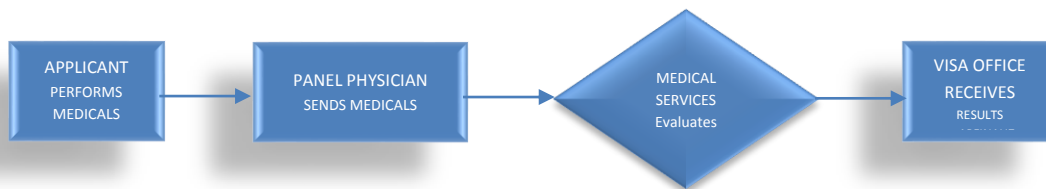
**DO YOUR MEDICAL EXAM UP-FRONT** 👍!

As an applicant, you have the option to proceed with an upfront medical exam before submitting your application, which allows for your application to be assessed with your medical results already underway.

\*Applications with upfront medicals are concluded 10 to 15 days faster! 😊

To perform your medical exams is your responsibility; all you need to do is contact your local Panel Physician and indicate that you would like to do your medicals upfront.\*\*

*This is how it works: Visit your local authorized Panel Physician and perform your medicals (please leave a valid e-mail address in case further medical tests are required) → Panel Physician sends your medical results to Medical Services Canada (applicants will receive a proof of completion of the upfront medical examination from the Panel Physician which you must submit with your application or email as soon as the medical exam is complete) → Medical Services evaluates your medical results → Visa Office attaches your medical results to your application.*



**Note:** Panel Physicians have the IMM 1017B – Upfront forms in their office.
