

SBDC Beginner Beekeeping Courses 2019



The Saskatchewan Beekeepers Development Commission, the Regina Bee Club, Saskatoon Bee Club and the Saskatchewan Ministry of Agriculture are pleased to offer the eighth annual **two-day beginner beekeepers courses in the Regina & Saskatoon areas**. Come and enjoy this two day course which enables participants to experience both theory and practical field experience. Instructors include members of Saskatchewan Beekeepers' Development Commission, Saskatchewan Ministry of Agriculture staff, and experienced beekeepers from the Regina Bee Club/Saskatoon Bee Club. All experience levels are welcome!

Workshop lessons include:

- Standard beekeeping equipment
- Honey bee colony assessments
- Basic bee biology
- Seasonal beekeeping responsibilities
- Extracting/ processing honey
- Disease and pest management practices
- *As much bee information as we can teach in two days!*

- Saskatoon -May 4 & 5, 2019 at Lalonde Honey Farms, Clavet (**mail-in registration deadline April 29, 2019**)
- Regina -May 11 & 12, 2019 at St. Joseph's Honey (**mail-in registration deadline May 6, 2019**)

Fee: \$300.00. Includes cost of lunch and snacks both days, and two manuals: "Honey Bee Disease and Pests 3rd Edition" and "Beekeeping in Western Canada". NOTE: Included in the registration fee, with an additional \$35.00 for lunch and snacks, one child under the age of 12 may accompany you to the course.
